

**Senate Resolution (2024:1)**

**Title:** Rightsizing the SGA Team

**Date:** February 6, 2024

- Whereas:** SGA officers are paid an hourly wage as compensation for their employment; and,
- Whereas:** This hourly wage has increased annually due to California state minimum wage legislation; and,
- Whereas:** The SGA budget has decreased in recent years as caused by the decrease in traditional undergraduate enrollment at APU; and,
- Whereas:** Wages for SGA officers were budgeted to exceed the apportioned budget allocated to SGA for the '23-'24 academic year; and,
- Whereas:** This dilemma will present itself on a yearly basis if no long-term solution is initiated by the current SGA; therefore,
- Be It Resolved:** SGA will not fill the roles vacated as a result of the resignations of Directors Vannatta and Leon and the subsequent promotion of Strategist Peck; and,
- Be It Further Resolved:** SGA will take measures to ensure there is a proper proportion of SGA officers relative to the forecasted SGA budget through the passing of legislative measures, be it the SGA bylaws or the SGA Constitution.
